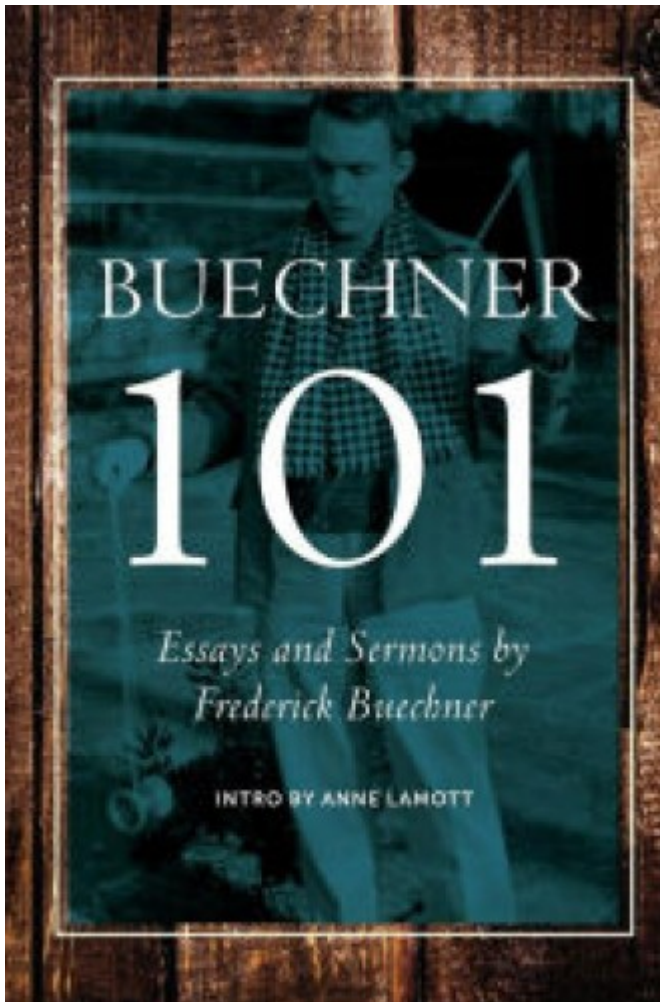

varied body of work gathers pieces from different genres and periods into a sampler to be savored, including pieces from *Whistling in the Dark*, *Wishful Thinking*, *Telling Secrets*, and his remarkable novel *Godric*. With an introduction by Anne Lamott and an enthusiastic tribute by Barbara Brown Taylor, the collection offers a rich range of life-giving words from a beloved theologian-novelist-preacher-speaker-essayist and encourager—the one who has found many ways to remind us that “God speaks into or out of the thick of our days.”
