stripping of our Lord's body at the crucifixion.*

The stripping proceeds without haste.

candelabra, the historic  
embroidery,  
the gilded Gospel.

The priest  
has handed his scarlet robe  
to the vergers.  
In the emptied chancel  
he pours oil and water

folds himself in shadow.

Lots are cast.  
Our hearts are wax.  
*Eloi, Eloi*, save us  
from the power of the dog.
