Celebrating a ban on fracking

Several years ago the *Century* <u>interviewed Sandra Steingraber</u> and reviewed her most recent book, *Raising Elijah*. Now, after six years of scientifically informed activism, Steingraber and others are celebrating in New York state, where Wednesday Governor Andrew Cuomo announced a ban on fracking.

"We cannot afford to make a mistake," <u>Cuomo said</u>. "The potential risks [of fracking] are too great. In fact, they are not even fully known."

Of yesterday's victory Steingraber <u>says this</u>: "It truly is a thing of beauty to see government living up to its purpose. Governments are tasked with protecting the health, safety and well-being of its citizenry."
