United Church of Christ buys \$5.3 million of medical debt in Chicago, launches national program

Almost 6,000 families on the South Side of Chicago have had their medical debt forgiven through a collaborative effort of the United Church of Christ and other partners. UCC leaders announced October 20 that church donations have wiped out \$5.3 million in medical debt for 5,888 Chicago families.
