Our Lady of Ferguson, by Mark Doox

Recently, faith leaders have been carrying prints of Mark Doox's *Our Lady of Ferguson* to protests in cities across the country in the wake of the police killing of George Floyd, Breonna Taylor, and numerous other black men and women. Doox works within an icon-styled form he calls Byz-Dada (Byzantine Dadaism). His images are informed by "American democratic and spiritual ideals, the African-American experience, humanistic existential reality, black folksy wisdom and
