Would John have preferred that Jesus baptize him instead of the other way around? Do baptizer and baptized constitute a hierarchy? How was Jesus' baptism fulfilling all righteousness? I wonder.

What did Jesus believe was happening in his baptism by John? Was he repenting of the sins of the nation? Have I repented of the sins of my nation? I wonder.

When Jesus came up out of the water, did he feel the Spirit descending on him as a dove? When I was baptized as an infant, did I feel the Spirit descending on me as a dove? Did the heavens also cry out at my baptism, "This is my beloved child"? I wonder.

Was Jesus' baptism a baptism into his ministry and into his death (Romans 6:3)? Is my baptism a baptism into my ministry and into my death? Was I buried with Christ through baptism into death to be raised again to new life? I hope so.
